He's performed on Broadway in The Original Cast of **Beautiful** and **The Book of Mormon**, as well as the national tours of **Dreamgirls**, **Rent** and **The Book of Mormon**. Douglas is also a renowned composer-lyricist and recent TV writer. His favorite writing credits include **Polkadots** (Off-Broadway Alliance winner), **Beau** (Adirondack Theatre Festival), **Chicken and Biscuits** (Queens Theatre) and **Five Points**, now in development with Hamilton Tony-winner Andy Blakenbuehler.
